



A Proclamation of the City of Mill Creek

WHEREAS, the City of Mill Creek officially incorporated on September 30, 1983; and

WHEREAS, since incorporating, it has expanded from 1.8 square miles with approximately 3,500 residents to 4.68 square miles with more than 21,000 residents; and

WHEREAS, Mill Creek is grateful for the service of former Mayors Hanson, Long, Epperly, Pruitt, Austin, Nielsen, Hodge, Ryan, Michelson, Ryan, Todd, Pruitt, and current Mayor Holtzclaw, as well as all the tireless dedication of each Councilmember who worked alongside each of them; and

WHEREAS, Mill Creek supports eleven City parks, miles of trails, a variety of shops and restaurants, and abundant community events, all providing opportunities to foster community spirit in support of our vision; and

WHEREAS, the City's vision is to provide an exceptional community experience that brings people together. A City where people are safe, natural beauty is preserved, neighborhoods flourish, businesses thrive, and recreational opportunities abound; and


WHEREAS, commemorative events and anniversaries contribute to community pride. Celebrating the 40th anniversary of incorporation provides an opportunity to both acknowledge Mill Creek's history and inspire a vision for our future; and

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Brian Holtzclaw, the Mayor of the City of Mill Creek, on behalf of the City Council, do hereby ask all Mill Creek community members join together to celebrate and proclaim September 2023 as the Mill Creek 40th Anniversary of Incorporation.
